
WHEREAS The Thirteenth Finance Commission has recommended that all urban local bodies having population in excess of one million must put in place a Fire Hazard Response and Mitigation Plan for their respective jurisdictions and has made it one of the mandatory conditions for release of performance grants to the states, which has been duly accepted by the Government of India,

WHEREAS in the State of Maharashtra, the cities of Greater Mumbai, Pune, Nagpur, Thane, Pimpri-Chinchwad, Nashik and Kalyan-Dombivli have a population of more than 1 million as per 2001 Census.

And, whereas the Fire Hazard Response and Mitigation Plans have accordingly been prepared by the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai, Pune Municipal Corporation, Nagpur Municipal Corporation, Thane Municipal Corporation, Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation, Nashik Municipal Corporation and Kalyan-Dombivli Municipal Corporation for their respective jurisdictions.

Now therefore it is hereby notified in the Government Gazette that the Fire Hazard Response and Mitigation Plans of the above said cities are available for the information of general public in the office of the Director, Maharashtra Fire Services, Government of Maharashtra and the concerned urban local body and on website of the Directorate of Maharashtra Fire Services (Address:- www.maharashtrafireservices.org.)
